A LONG WALK TO ETHICS EDUCATION

The 6th International Conference on Ethics Education will take place in Stellenbosch, South Africa on October 3-5, 2018. The Conference is organized under the auspices of the International Association for Education in Ethics (<https://www.ethicsassociation.org/>). The conference theme “A long walk to ethics education” resonates with the autobiography of the iconic late President of South Africa, Dr Nelson Rolihlahla Mandela. As such, the conference will focus on keynote addresses, various oral presentations and master class sessions that highlight and interrogate ethics education as a complex and dynamic process characterised by life-long perseverance, courage and integrity.

Abstract Guidelines

1. General Conditions

- The deadline to submit abstracts is **Friday, 20 April 2018**. Abstracts received after this date will not be accepted.
- Only abstracts for oral presentations will be considered.
- Only abstracts submitted in English will be considered.
- Only abstracts in MS Word format will be considered; 1.5 line spacing and Verdana 12 font size.
- Abstracts should represent original work and/or ideas that has not previously been submitted for publication or presented at another conference.
- A maximum of two (2) abstracts may be submitted per presenting author.
- Abstracts must not exceed the maximum word limit (300 words).
- All abbreviations must be spelled out on first use.
- To be formally accepted and included in the conference programme, the presenter must register as a Conference delegate and have paid the registration fees by Friday, 29th June 2018.

2. Abstract Categories

Each abstract submission must clearly indicate the preferred category (i.e. one or two categories may be indicated) of the conference theme in which the conference paper is positioned; see below the list of categories. The programme manager and scientific committee will as far as possible honour the presenter’s preference/s, but retains the right to re-allocate the paper to a different category where appropriate and/or required. The scientific committee will consider a broad range of paper themes and approaches within the scope of the listed conference categories, including creative and/or alternative approaches and/or ideas to current ethics education endeavours. As such, we have the honour to invite prospective paper presenters to submit one or two abstracts oral presentations in the following conference paper categories:

- Ethics Education in Medical/Health Sciences
- Ethics Education in Research
- Ethics Education in Law

- Ethics Education in Art, Photography and Drama
- Ethics Education in Environmental, Agriculture and Animal/Wildlife Sciences
- Ethics Education in Journalism, Humanities and Religion
- Ethics Education in Sport, Psychology and Educational Insight
- Ethics Education in Social Sciences
- Ethics Education in Business and Management
- Ethics Education in Engineering, Architecture, ICT and Technology
- Ethics Education in Natural Sciences and Nanotechnology
- Ethics Education in Open Distance E Learning

3. Presentation Time Allocation

- Presenters will be allocated 15 minutes to present their papers, followed by 5 minutes to respond to questions and/or comments from the audience

4. Abstract Layout

- **Title:** Indicate the abstract title in uppercase letters; maximum 15 words
- **Abstract Category:** Indicate the letter (A, B, C, etc) of the preferred programme category (maximum of two categories per abstract allowed); see list of Categories in section 2 above.
- **Author/s Information:** Clearly indicate the following for each of the presentation authors and underline the name of the presenting author:

Last Name (uppercase format)
Country
Institution/ Organisation
E-mail address
Audio/visual equipment needed (Yes/No and specify)
- **Body of Abstract:**
Background
Aim/Purpose of Paper
Description of Empirical Methods and/or Philosophical Perspective
